Buttercup

Buttercup have been enjoying lots of outdoor learning and exploring. We have enjoyed water and sand play both indoors and out this has helped us develop our fine and gross motor skills. We have also been exploring colours through messy play, body painting, sensory items and much more. This is encouraging the children to develop their senses, creativity, cognitive awareness, literacy, fine and gross motor skills.

Daisy

Daisy children have shown a lot more interest in our house corner recently, we have therefore made this area bigger so that more children can enjoy this at the same time. Playing in the house corner and with our dolls allows the child to role play. We also love action songs and dancing, some of our favourite songs to play through alexa are 'down in the jungle', 'row, row, row your boat', 'sleeping bunnies and of course 'baby shark'. We have also been working on our manners at mealtimes reminding the children to use please and thank you. The daisy children are getting very good at counting and we often practise counting from 0-10.

Snowdrop

We have been enjoying caring for babies, washing, and drying them and chatting lots about how we care for them. Jumping and balancing on tyres in the garden has been a great interest too. (3)

COVID 19

To help us deliver a successful programme for our nursery community we would ask that all parents and carers continue to follow the COVID 19 regulations and follow those requirements to the letter.
