Lower garden

The lower garden now has a permanent sand pit with canopy. We will continue to develop the garden area and we hope the next phase will see some artificial grass in the top section along with our wild flower area.

Top Garden

The top garden is now open and the children have full access to the area. The children have been involved in looking at a risk benefit approach to the garden. This means moving away from the traditional deficit model that takes a risk-averse approach, which can unnecessarily restrict children's experiences. The children have developed safety rules for the garden, please speak to your child about this at home.

Can all parents please enter the garden area when collecting your child/ren for feedback from the staff. Children are not permitted to leave the garden area on their own.

Child Absence

Please ensure you contact the nursery by 9am if your child is going to be absent from nursery or will be getting dropped off later.

Appropriate Clothing

Can all parents and carers please provide appropriate outdoor clothing for your child. The nicer weather is here and hopefully will stay for a little while can we please ask for lots of named sunhats being brought in for every child. Children who are not dressed appropriately will not be allowed to participate in our outdoor play opportunities.
